Formation

Over the years there have been many
changes to the Park, resulting in it falling
into disrepair and suffering from neglect.
The castle was demolished in 1964, the
paddling pool was filled in and grassed
over in 1988, and when the Pavilion was
demolished in 1998 a group of local
residents formed the Friends of Beaumont
Park to act as a pressure group working
with Kirklees Council with a view to
restoring the Park.

Following members approval given at our
AGM in December 2008 we applied to
become a Company Limited by Guarantee
and with effect from 1 April 2009 we
became a Limited Company and on 23
April 2009 we became a Registered Charity.
